City Clerk Nicole Bolden Invites Applications for Vacancies on the Bloomington/Monroe County Human Rights Commission

BLOOMINGTON—The City of Bloomington Office of the City Clerk is accepting applications to fill vacant positions on the Bloomington/Monroe County Human Rights Commission.

The **Bloomington/Monroe County Human Rights Commission** designed to enforce Bloomington's Human Rights Ordinance in a fair and timely manner, to educate community members about their rights and responsibilities under various civil rights laws, to raise awareness on all human rights issues, to ensure that contractors and subcontractors on city jobs pay employees applicable common wages, to ensure that the City, as an employer, governmental entity and provider of public accommodations, complies with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA), and to provide the community with information about the ADA.

The membership on the commission shall be representatives of the community and shall be city or county residents.

The commission usually meets the third Monday of each month at City Hall starting at 5 p.m. Members of the public are welcome to attend these meetings. For more information, please see the Bloomington Municipal Code 2.23.100.
