



All-Options Hoosier Diaper Program Adopted by Tandem Frequently Asked Questions

Tandem is adopting the Hoosier Diaper Program (HDP) and Period Equity Program (PEP) from All-Options. When are HDP and PEP moving to Tandem?

The last day of supply distribution at All-Options will be Wednesday, March 26, 2025. Tandem will begin distributing supplies Tuesday April 1, 2025.

Why are HDP and PEP moving to Tandem?

Last month, [All-Options shared](#) that we are facing a very real possibility of closing the organization by the end of June 2025 — [learn more here](#). We have been assessing ways to sustain All-Options in a significantly reduced and/or restructured capacity and, sadly, we are no longer able to sustain HDP and PEP. All-Options identified Tandem as a local organization with shared values where HDP and PEP can continue to serve Bloomington residents.

Will Tandem use the same process for requesting diapers and supplies?

No. Clients will no longer need to reserve specific pick-up windows. Instead, people can drop in at Tandem, located at 2613 E 3rd St, Bloomington, any day Tandem is open (see tandembloomington.org/calendar for hours). Supplies available include diapers, wipes, menstrual products, condoms, and other parenting essentials. Families can take home up to a month's supply of diapers per visit.

Is the All-Options Pregnancy Resource Center (AOPRC) closed?

No. All-Options staff will continue to work from the AOPRC and people can visit us by appointment only. If or when we close the AOPRC, we will announce this clearly through our website, social media, and our newsletter.

Also, All-Options will host a “Free Day” at 3pm - 6pm on Wednesday April 2, 2025, at 1014 S Walnut St, in Bloomington for local residents to pick up other items that have been donated to All-Options. Pizza will be available, while supplies last. This is for our community only and the press is not invited.



Throughout the month of April, All-Options staff will provide technical assistance to Tandem to support a smooth transition process.

Can I still apply for abortion funding from the All-Options [Hoosier Abortion Fund](#)?

Yes! The Hoosier Abortion Fund is still running as usual, and is open for anyone in Indiana who needs support to get an abortion. Organizations may still refer clients and patients to HAF for financial, logistical, and emotional support for abortion access. All-Options will continue to provide diapers for HAF clients upon request. Reach the Hoosier Abortion Fund by texting or calling us at 1-812-727-4423.
