Dear Judge Bradley:

My name is Carson Hendrickson, I am writing to respectfully request additional time to remain in the home, I and my children, have occupied for the last 9 years.

I was informed about a month ago, that we could stay another 2 years, By the Monroe County parks and Recs., along with notice of upcoming house structural inspection.

Based on that information. I believed I had adequate time to find alternative housing and begin reasonable transition.

However, I was informed, that Miss Huntington had passed away 2 years ago, I was never informed until it was too late.

Since then, I have felt increasing pressure to vacate, especially, after being told, by the Parks that when their names go on the property that we may 60 days, to vacate.

This sudden change has been distressing to my family.

I have used my own resources over the years to maintain and repair the home and have treated the property, with care and responsibility.

I was just approved for a home through the Habitat for Humanity program and while, I'm deeply grateful, the new home is not yet complete. I'm simply asking for enough time to stay, until construction is finished so my family can transition to our permanent housing without becoming displaced or homeless. I have put my whole heart into that place.

As you know, affordable housing in Bloomington is limited. I am doing my best to follow all the procedures, responsibly and respectfully, and would be grateful, if the parks or your court, may provide in allowing us to remain until the Habitat for Humanity project is complete. The Parks have not been honest with us and never intended to let us stay as far as I can see there should be no reason for that, when we been trying to leave on good terms.

if needed I can provide documentation to support all information I've stated including approval from Habitat for Humanity and two witnesses that heard my conversations with the Parks
