**AGREED MOTION TO MODIFY THE PARTIES' REQUIREMENT TO MOVE TO
DISMISS CASE AND AGREEMENT TO EXTEND PRIVATE SETTLEMENT
AGREEMENT FOR 90 DAYS**

Come now the parties, by their counsel, and say that:

1. On August 14, 2009, the parties submitted their Private Settlement Agreement in this case. (Dkt. No. 52).
2. Paragraph 24 of the Private Settlement Agreement provides that:

The parties agree that absent an order from the court or a subsequent written agreement by the parties, this Agreement, if approved, should remain in effect until October 1, 2011, at which time the case should be dismissed. The parties agree that this dismissal should be with prejudice as to this action only, preventing this action from being revived by any class member.
3. On December 3, 2009, this Court entered its Order Finding Private Settlement Agreement to be Fair, Reasonable and Adequate Pursuant to Rule 23(e) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure. (Dkt. No. 62).

4. In its Order, this Court ordered that “pursuant to the Private Settlement Agreement, this case is now deemed dismissed without prejudice. The parties shall move for dismissal with prejudice on October 1, 2011.”

5. By prior agreements of the parties and orders of this Court the dismissal dates have been extended to the current date of January 15, 2026. (Dkt. Nos. 65, 70, 72, 74, 78, 80, 82, 84, 86, 88, 90, 96, 98).

6. Plaintiffs’ counsel has determined that the case should be dismissed but is requesting an extension of the Private Settlement Agreement for 90 days so that notice can be given to the class of the dismissal.

WHEREFORE, the parties agree that the private settlement agreement in this case be extended 90 days to April 15, 2026, and move this Court to extend the time that they are to move to dismiss this case with prejudice to April 15, 2026, and for all other proper relief

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
