

[News release from Bloomington Transit on Jan. 24, 2026 at 7:15 p.m.]

Due to potential hazardous winter weather conditions impacting the region, Bloomington Public Transportation is suspending all services for Sunday, January 25, 2026.

The decision was made to ensure the safety of passengers, drivers, and road crews. Heavy snow accumulation, ice, and high winds are expected to create unsafe travel conditions across the service area.

“We understand that transit service is essential for many in our community,” said John Connell, BPTC General Manager. “However, safety must be our top priority. Our team is closely monitoring road conditions and weather forecasts, and we will resume service as soon as it is safe to do so.”

During the suspension period, customers are advised to avoid unnecessary travel and stay tuned for service updates. A decision regarding Monday's services will be made Sunday night.
