Bloomington Press Club to Host Panel on the Future of IU Student Media

Bloomington, IN — The Bloomington Press Club will host a luncheon panel discussion titled “**The Future of IU Student Media**” on **Wednesday, January 28**, examining recent changes in Indiana University’s student media landscape and what lies ahead for student journalism.

The discussion will be moderated by **Bob Zaltsberg**, host of WFIU’s Noon Edition, and will feature a panel of voices representing leadership, student perspective, and law. Panelists include **Greg Menkedick**, Advertising Director at IU Student Media; **Andrew Miller**, co-editor-in-chief for the Indiana Daily Student; and **Steve Sanders**, associate dean and professor at the IU Maurer School of Law.

Indiana University and the Indiana Daily Student have recently been in the headlines following significant changes to student media operations and the publication of the newspaper. This timely conversation will provide clarity around those developments and explore how the IDS and other student media organizations plan to move forward.

The event will take place at **Lamkin Hall, Room C131**, on the **Ivy Tech Community College** campus in Bloomington. Networking begins at **11:40 a.m.**, followed by the program **11:50 a.m. - 12:45 p.m.**. Guests are welcome.
