Bloomington Police Continue to Investigate Lauren Spierer Case

Tomorrow, June 3rd, 2026, will mark the 15th anniversary since the disappearance of Lauren Spierer. Lauren was last seen around 4:30 a.m. on June 3rd, 2011, near the intersection of N College Avenue and W 11th Street. The investigation remains very active, and detectives with the Bloomington Police Department continue to share information regularly with law enforcement partners from Federal, State and local agencies in an effort to utilize every available resource as we work to locate Lauren and determine who is responsible for her disappearance.

Since June 3rd, 2025, the Bloomington Police Department has received and investigated 23 new tips which resulted in multiple interviews and case supplements. To date, Lauren's missing person case has 980 supplemental reports that have been generated. We continue to seek assistance from the public and ask that anyone with any information, no matter how small it may seem, to contact the Bloomington Police Department and report it.

We remain unwavering in our promise to pursue every lead and exhaust every available resource in our search for Lauren. No matter how much time passes, our commitment to finding answers for the family and friends of Lauren will not falter.
