On June 3, 2026, at approximately 7:10 a.m., officers responded to an apartment in the 500 block of W Hays Court in reference to a weapons complaint. The caller reported that two males had arrived at their apartment and one of the males entered without being invited and fired multiple rounds from a handgun before leaving the area. The suspects were gone upon the arrival of officers, but officers did indeed locate multiple bullet holes in the walls of the apartment.

Officers then began checking neighboring apartments, which were occupied by numerous adults and children, and located holes in their walls as well, indicating that the bullets had traveled into their apartments. There were no injuries reported. Investigators were able to determine the identities of the two males as Shawn M. Wilcox (26, transient) and Cody L. Riley (26, Bloomington).

Surveillance footage corroborated the victim's statements. On the morning of June 8th, 2026, investigators located both Wilcox and Riley in an apartment in the 2400 block of S Winslow Court. Both were taken into custody and transported to the Bloomington Police Department for interviews. Once the interviews were complete, the arrestees were remanded to the Monroe County Jail for the following charges:

- Shawn M. Wilcox (DOB 03/28/2000): Burglary, level 2 felony; Criminal Recklessness, level 5 felony; Intimidation with a Deadly Weapon, level 5 felony
- Cody L. Riley (DOB 03/26/2000): Burglary, level 2 felony; Criminal Recklessness, level 5 felony

Under Indiana law, criminal charges are merely accusations and the defendant is presumed innocent unless and until proven guilty in a court of law.
