Summary of Contract:

The City of Bloomington Department of Public Works would like to utilize the extension option that is contained in the current agreement with Republic Services to provide municipal solid waste and single-stream recycling processing services. This agreement renewal is for an additional 2 years (current agreement terminates on December 31, 2021). The only change from the current agreement is a one time, 3% increase in the single-stream recycling processing fee that would take effect on January 1, 2022. In all other respects, the agreement shall remain in effect as originally written.

On October 16, 2018, the Board of Public Works awarded the Agreement for Disposal Services of Municipal Solid Waste and Single-Stream Recycling to Republic Services. The Initial Term of this Agreement began on January 1, 2019, with a termination date of December 31, 2021. This Renewal #1 supplements that Agreement, as follows:

1. Article 4. Term of Agreement states that the Agreement may be renewed for an additional three (3) years, provided neither party gives written notice of its intent not to renew this Agreement.
2. Republic Services and the City of Bloomington wish to renew this Agreement for an additional two (2) years. This Renewal Term shall begin on January 1, 2022, and terminate on December 31, 2023.
3. In all other respects, the Agreement shall remain in effect as originally written.
